



Saint Jeanne de Lestonnac Catholic School 2019 Summer Camp Program



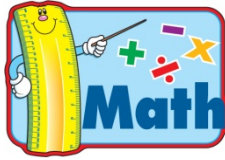
Over the past few summers, we have had very enriching summer camps for our Saint Jeanne students. This summer is no exception! Our focus this year will be Language Arts and Math in the mornings, and Fine Arts in the afternoon. (Please note that there will not be any camps the week of June 17-21.)



5th grade - Middle School Math Camp: June 24-28, July 1-5, July 8-12 & July 15-19

8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

This is a four week camp that will have students working at their individual levels focusing on their math skills and math facts. It is recommended that students attend at least two weeks of camp. (We will divide students by grade levels/ course levels) Students will explore strategies to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division problems using manipulatives and critical thinking processes. The students will also practice math facts and investigate concepts in algebra, geometry and measurement. In addition, students will be able to work on their summer math requirements.



Elementary Math Camp: June 24-28, July 1-5 - 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Grades 2, 3, 4

Number Sense, Problem Solving and Hands-On Explorations: students will explore strategies to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division problems using manipulatives and critical thinking processes. The students will also practice math facts and investigate concepts in algebra, geometry and measurement. In addition, students will be able to work on their summer math requirement.



Elementary Language Arts Camp: July 8th- 12th and July 15th – 19th

Grades 2 to 4 - 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

This program will use short stories as a way to drive deeper reading comprehension. Children will also develop their writing and expand verbal skills through use of sensory language. Students will be grouped by age and reading levels. In addition, students will have access to Accelerated Reading Tests.

Middle School Language Arts Camp: July 8th – 12th and July 15 – 19th

Grades 5-8 - 8:30 am to 11:30 am

This course is designed for those students who would like to improve and refine their reading comprehension skills. We will be using a variety of literature to get your students excited about learning. In addition, students will have access to Accelerated Reading Tests.



Stepping Stones Camp: June 24-28, July 8-12 & July 15-19

Grades K & 1 - 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

This program will use a resource program that integrates dramatic play, math, art, and language arts to help prepare children entering into kindergarten. Students entering 1st grade will engage in more challenging versions of the activities to help prepare them for first grade in the fall.



Sports Camp: June 24 - 28

Grades 1-8 – 12:00-3:00

Students will enjoy learning basic and fundamental skills of basketball, volleyball, and soccer. They will be grouped by age level and experience. Coach Mrs. Bendykowski has a variety of activities planned for loads of summer fun!



Culinary Arts Camp: July 1, 2, 3, 5

Grades – 1-3 – 8:30-11:30

Grades – 4-8 – 12:00 – 3:00

Beat the heat in our cool kitchen as we heat up some hot NEW yummy recipes! Whether you like to bake, create, roast, sauté, fry or just blend, we have a camp for you! These camps will be themed according to the grade leveled groups.

Grades 5-8 – 12:00 to 3:00 pm

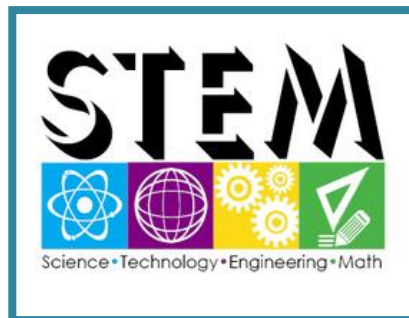

FFA (Future Farmers of America) /Camp: July 8-12

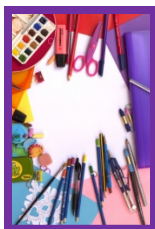
Grades K-4 – 12:00 to 3:00 pm
